#### SCENE 1: LUNCHROOM

Peter Fyre sits at a high school lunch table. Dylan Barnes storms in with a lunch tray.

DYLAN

Dude!

PETER

What is it this time?

DYLAN

They told me I can't wear my Hell's Bells shirt anymore!

PETER

Wait, seriously?

DYLAN

Yes! It's profane, apparently.

PETER

So stupid, dude.

DYLAN

I'm just sick of it all, Peter!

PETER

I know, bro. I am too. All I've got is you and my drum kit.

DYLAN

And all I'm doing is going to class and playing guitar and doing nothing with anything. I want to get outta here!

PETER

You're telling me. I don't even want to get out of bed some mornings.

DYLAN

A record deal in L.A. That's what I need. So do you.

PETER

Dylan, I think you might've finally had a good idea.

DYLAN

What?

PETER

Dude. You play guitar. I play drums. We need a record deal.

(catching)

And we can get it together!

PETER

There ya go.

DYLAN

Dude, we got it! We'll start a band!

PETER

Well, not yet. I've never seen a two-person rock band do anything notable.

DYLAN

Uh, the Black Keys?

PETER

They tour with a live band. We need a full band. And I think I know where to start.

We hear Harrison playing acoustic guitar and singing as girls pass by him.

HARRISON

I JUST WANNA SING YOU LOVE SONGS CALL YOU UP ON YOUR PHONE I I JUST WANNA SING YOU LOVE SONGS BABY YOU'LL NEVER BE ALONE

He keeps playing.

DYLAN

You can't be serious.

PETER

I don't see anyone else with the balls to just get up and start playing! Plus, he's pretty good.

DYLAN

Fine. You ask him.

PETER

Whatever, man.

Peter approaches Harrison and Dylan trails behind.

PETER (CONT'D)

Hey, Harrison, right?

**HARRISON** 

Yeah! You're Peter!

PETER

Uh, yeah.

HARRISON

You play the drums!

PETER

Yeah I do..?

HARRISON

All the girls totally love you man. Leave some for the rest of us!

Dylan stifles a laugh.

HARRISON (CONT'D)

And you're Dylan! Absolute chick magnet on the guitar!

PETER

Haha, yeah, right. So me and my buddy Dylan want to start a band and we were-

HARRISON

I'm gonna stop you there. I'm in.

PETER

(to Dylan)

That was easy.

HARRISON

Man, I've heard you play and you're all "duga duga duga doo doo doo chhhh!" and Dylan, you're like "weedley weedley woo woo!"

PETER

Haha, yeah, thanks. Uh, I'll hit you up.

They walk away from Harrison awkwardly.

DYLAN

So that's rhythm guitar. Still need bass. Can't we just get another guitar player to play bass? They're pretty much the same thing and who knows anyone who even plays bass?

PETER

You can't be serious.

DYLAN

What? No?

PETER

A good bass player is really hard to come by.

Ok. I submit to your expertise.

PETER

There's a guy in Jazz band that's really good. Let's see if we can find him.

DYLAN

You listen to jazz? No wonder you're depressed.

PETER

Hey!

SCENE 2: BAND ROOM

As Dylan and Peter walk into the band room, Scott is in there jamming to some jazz. He plays to the end of the song before the two approach.

PETER

Hey man.

SCOTT

Can I help you?

PETER

Oh, we were just listening to you play.

DYLAN

You're really good.

SCOTT

Thanks. I've been playing all my life so I hope I'm good.

DYLAN

Do you play styles other than jazz?

SCOTT

I dabble.

DYLAN

(to Peter)

He dabbles.

SCOTT

I try to keep up with just about everything. Rock, R&B, pop, all that stuff.

PETER

That's awesome. Me and my buddy Dylan are working on putting together a band and are looking for a bass player.

(to Peter)

A bassist.

SCOTT

That's cool. I'm actually not really playing with a group right now, so you're in luck.

DYLAN

Let's go!

SCOTT

I'm Scott, nice to meet you.

DYLAN

Dylan. And this is Peter.

PETER

Pleasure.

DYLAN

I'll find you on Instagram and hit you up, man.

SCOTT

Sounds good. I'll see you around.

# SCENE 3: BASEMENT PRACTICE

Dylan stands shredding on his guitar for a moment or two. Peter walks in. Dylan doesn't notice-- he's in the zone. Peter sneaks back behind the drum kit. Near the end of a phrase, Peter hits a cymbal loudly. Dylan stops and Peter starts playing. After a minute or so, Peter finishes.

DYLAN

Damn, son! You can play!

PETER

Haha, thank you. It's what I spend all of my free time doing.

DYLAN

Well then you'd better be good!

Harrison enters with his quitar.

HARRISON

Was that you playing a second ago?

PETER

Yeah, that was me.

HARRISON

You're amazing!

DYLAN

See! I told you!

PETER

You flatter me.

Scott enters with his bass in a case.

SCOTT

Fellas.

PETER

Hey, Scott. Good to see ya.

DYLAN

Scott, meet Harrison. Harrison, Scott.

They shake hands.

DYLAN (CONT'D)

Gentlemen, now that we're all here, we should get to the first order of business. What in the hell are we gonna play?

Crickets.

DYLAN (CONT'D)

Ok then. I'll start. I play rock and classic rock mostly, but throw in some punk as well.

PETER

Uh, I play rock and metal mostly but can play whatever.

HARRISON

I'll play anything you want me to. You name it.

SCOTT

I'm mostly jazz, but rock is fun too.

DYLAN

Alright, good, so we all share rock. Are we talking like Bon Jovi or Green Day?

SCOTT

I mean, I'd be down for something in the middle. I want to play stuff that says something, though.

PETER

Oh, we've got plenty to say.

HARRISON

About what?

About this place, this school, this town. It sucks! And me and Peter are planning on getting out.

SCOTT

Now there's something we can work with.

DYLAN

Oh, I've got it. Peter, give me a rock beat, 4/4.

Dylan snaps the tempo for him.

DYLAN (CONT'D)

Alright, you two, follow me!

They slowly build on each other until they are all together. The set morphs into:

DYLAN

PRINCIPAL HILL

Mr. Rose, is this band going to be a problem?

MR. ROSE

I don't know. It could be.

NANCY

I kind of liked it.

PRINCIPAL HILL

Quiet, Nancy. All of the students went crazy for it.

MR. ROSE

This is the last thing we need when we're trying to get new families to move into the district.

PRINCIPAL HILL

They're gonna cause a mutiny amongst all the teens. We'll talk more about what to do in our meeting next week.

MR. ROSE

Drive home safely.

### SCENE 5: HOUSE PARTY

#### DYLAN

Thank you for all of the love from the last few weeks. You're really makin' this little band feel big. For our last song tonight, we're gonna show you a new song, and it's pretty close to me. It was inspired by my last breakup. Anyways, here's "The Thought of Me".

Avah takes a step closer to Dylan.

AVAH

You know, sometimes I just wish that other people could see it like you and I do.

Dylan closes the gap between them.

DYLAN

It does look like we see eye to eye.

They kiss.

AVAH

Oh, wow.

DYLAN

No?

AVAH

No! I mean, yes! Very yes!

You have a way with words.

AVAH

Just-- shut up.

They kiss again.

AVAH (CONT'D)

How about we join the party?

DYLAN

Oh, yeah. I forgot about it.

They go off together.

SCENE 6: PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE

PRINCIPAL HILL

Thanks for coming in, Bill.

MR. ROSE

Happy to help.

PRINCIPAL HILL

Dylan Barnes to the office, Dylan Barnes to the office.

(To Nancy)

Can you bring him in here when he gets here? Thanks. Oh, and is there any coffee left out there?

NANCY

Yes sir. And I'll go check.

PRINCIPAL HILL

Thank you.

MR. ROSE

Didya go to the boy's basketball game last night?

PRINCIPAL HILL

No, I usually only like watching our team win. And it's been a while since that's happened.

Nancy leads Dylan in. She hands Principal Hill a cup of coffee.

PRINCIPAL HILL (CONT'D)

Amazing, thank you, Nancy. Hello, Dylan.

DYLAN

Mr. Hill.

PRINCIPAL HILL

Do you know why I asked you to come in today?

DYLAN

No, sir, I do not.

PRINCIPAL HILL

Well, you've been making quite the stir lately with your band.

DYLAN

Oh, my band? Yeah, man, we're just having fun.

PRINCIPAL HILL

Hm, it sure sounds like it. What's the name of your band again?

DYLAN

We Hate It Here.

PRINCIPAL HILL

And I believe that is my issue.

DYLAN

What, that we hate it here?

PRINCIPAL HILL

Well, no, but mostly just that you're screaming it out to everyone else.

DYLAN

Sorry, I guess.

PRINCIPAL HILL

You're fine, you're fine. I just wanted to ask you to... how do I say this? I want you to soften your message a touch.

DYLAN

You what?

PRINCIPAL HILL

You know, maybe write songs about other things. Like girls or... things. I don't know. Just be a little more positive.

DYLAN

Dude, I don't have anything else to write about here. There's nothing to do! I hate it here and I'm gonna tell everyone I hate it here.

PRINCIPAL HILL

We haven't had a winning season since you were in school.

PRINCIPAL HILL

DYLAN

And set up one of the little tables at lunch that everyone just ignores?

PRINCIPAL HILL

Dylan. Just stop. Stop the band. Focus on school, on college!

DYLAN

No, you just stop! You don't get it! This music is all we've got!

Dylan storms out, grabs his guitar and begins to sing/play. The band joins him
